

Clinical Fellowships in Lymphoma and Myeloma

Lymphoma Site Group Princess Margaret Hospital/Ontario Cancer Institute

These fellowships focus on the treatment of patients with lymphoid malignancies including lymphoma, multiple myeloma and chronic lymphocytic leukemia. The Lymphoma and Myeloma Site group with Medical Oncology and Hematology at PMH see approximately 400 new patients with lymphoma and 300 new patients with plasma cell disorders annually. The site has an active autologous stem cell transplant programme and performs 160-180 autotransplants per year, and an active and growing drug development programme. We have an extensive publication record in the treatment of lymphoid malignancies and plasma cell dyscrasias. Fellows are provided the opportunity and encouraged to conduct research projects and prepare manuscripts describing their research. These positions offer a unique opportunity to gain an increased understanding of the role of hematopoietic cell transplantation in specific disease subsets and participate in an active clinical and translational research programme. Clinical and research experience is very flexible and intended to meet the educational and career goals of the applicant. Fellowships are for one or two years and starting dates are negotiable.
