The Department of Medical Oncology and Haematology, CancerCare Manitoba (CCMB), in conjunction with the Oncology Programme, Winnipeg Regional Health Authority (WRHA); and, the Section of Haematology/Oncology, Department of Internal Medicine, Faculty of Medicine, University of Manitoba (U of M), Winnipeg, are seeking applications for positions within our Programme. The successful candidate will be expected to develop a productive disease site group-related clinical or basic research programme, to participate in the teaching programmes of CancerCare Manitoba and the University of Manitoba, and to provide quality care to patients with malignant and benign hematological disorders as part of a multidisciplinary team. Candidates must have specialty qualifications in Internal Medicine and Hematology in the country of current practice and must be eligible for registration with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba. Certification in Hematology by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada is preferred. The Department of Medical Oncology and Haematology, CCMB, and the Section of Haematology/Oncology, Department of Internal Medicine, Faculty of Medicine, U of M, consists of 30 faculty members based at the two CCMB sites located at the two U of M-affiliated teaching hospitals, the Health Sciences Centre and St. Boniface General Hospital. In addition, the group provides services to the four Hospital-based Community Oncology sites within the WRHA. The group operates active clinical and basic science research programmes in solid tissue and haematological malignancies, the pathogenesis and management of infection in cancer patients, blood and marrow transplantation, quality of life in cancer, cancer epidemiology, red cell disorders, and bleeding and thrombotic disorders. We offer unique opportunities to develop new and innovative clinical and/or basic research directly or in collaboration with the Manitoba Institute of Cell Biology, CCMB.

Qualifications: This is a University of Manitoba academic appointment. Remuneration income and rank will be commensurate with experience and qualifications. Competitive remuneration and excellent benefits packages are offered. CancerCare Manitoba, the Winnipeg Regional Health Authority, and the Faculty of Medicine, University of Manitoba, encourages applications from qualified men and women, including visible minorities, Aboriginal peoples, and persons with disabilities.
