We are looking for a hematologist to join our provincial hematology team in Regina. The provincial hematology program focuses on the diagnosis and treatment of patients with both benign and malignant hematological conditions, including full provision of autologous and allogeneic stem cell transplant services. The Regina program is operated in partnership with the Regina Qu'Appelle Health Region.

Successful applicants will report to the Provincial Leader of Hematology. All Hematologists receive an academic appointment in the Department of Hematology, College of Medicine, University of Saskatchewan, and privileges in the Regina Qu'Appelle Health Region. Teaching and research responsibilities are an integral part of program activities.

Preference will be given to applicants who are certified in hematology by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, but applicants with equivalent qualifications may be considered. Successful applicants will be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan. In accordance with Canadian immigration requirements, preference will be given to Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada.
