

Clinical Fellowships in Lymphoma

Lymphoma Site Group

These fellowships focus on the treatment of patients with lymphoid malignancies including lymphoma and chronic lymphocytic leukemia. The Lymphoma and Myeloma Site group within the Division of Medical Oncology and Hematology at PM sees approximately 500 new patients with lymphoma annually. We had the largest autologous stem cell transplant programme in Canada, and perform over 280 inpatient and outpatient autotransplants per year, including 60-70 for aggressive lymphomas and Hodgkin lymphoma. The Site Group has an active and growing drug development programme and participates in or leads a range of phase I-III clinical trials. Members of the Site Group have an extensive publication record in the treatment of lymphoid malignancies, including systemic therapy, radiation and ASCT. Fellows are provided the opportunity and encouraged to conduct original research projects and prepare manuscripts describing their research. These positions offer a unique opportunity to gain increased understanding current disease biology and the evolving treatment landscape in lymphoma, and participate in an active clinical and translational research programme. Clinical and research experience is very flexible and intended to meet the educational and career goals of the applicant. Fellowships are for one or two years and starting dates are negotiable.
