Hematology Fellowship Opportunity: Malignant Hematology & Stem Cell Transplant Fellowship Saskatchewan Cancer Agency

We are currently offering a 1 year clinical malignant hematology and stem cell transplant fellowship at the Saskatchewan Cancer Agency with our Provincial Hematology program.

The Saskatchewan Cancer Agency is responsible for the provision of cancer services within the Province of Saskatchewan and operates two comprehensive cancer treatment and research centres. The provincial hematology program focuses on the treatment of patients with lymphomas, myeloma and acute leukemia and performs all autologous stem cell transplants for a population base of one million people. The agency has started the allogeneic stem cell transplant program which serves the province of Saskatchewan. The program, operated in partnership with the Saskatoon Health Region, is based in Saskatoon but is provincial in scope.

Applicants should have completed post-graduate training in Internal Medicine and Hematology. Applicants must be eligible for and maintain registration with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan for an educational register license. Applicants must also be eligible for and maintain privileges with the Saskatoon Health Region as determined by their credentialing process (which includes a criminal record check and immunization requirements).
