

ACADEMIC HEMATOLOGIST

Department of Medicine, McMaster University

The Department of Medicine, Faculty of Health Sciences at McMaster University and St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton (SJHH) are seeking an Academic Hematologist to join the Division of Hematology & Thromboembolism as a Clinician Educator.

The successful applicant will be a full-time member of the Division of Hematology & Thromboembolism and will be expected to contribute to the academic mission of the Division and Department of Medicine; ideally with a focus on leadership in medical education and/or quality improvement. Clinical responsibilities will include outpatient clinic coverage of patients with general hematologic and thrombotic disease and inpatient hematology and thrombosis consultations.

The Division of Hematology & Thromboembolism is internationally recognized for its excellence in research, education and patient care. SJHH, which is a McMaster University teaching hospital, provides comprehensive health services to residents of Hamilton-Niagara-Haldimand-Brant and the surrounding region. This multi-site, regional, tertiary centre is renowned for its strength in respiratory care, kidney and urinary care, mental health and addictions, surgical services, cancer surgery and women's and infants' care.

Applicants will have completed specialty training in Hematology and be certified or be eligible for certification in Hematology by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and must be eligible for licensure in the province of Ontario. Formal training in education and/or educational research would be an asset, as would expertise in thrombosis.

Remuneration will be based on level of experience and in line with remuneration for academic Hematologists in Ontario. Academic rank will be commensurate with successful candidate's qualifications and experience.
