The Division of Hematology is one of 15 divisions in the Department of Medicine, providing compassionate care of patients with hematological disorders whose disease may be benign or malignant. Members are involved in teaching hematology to undergraduate and postgraduate students and to physicians locally, nationally and internationally in continuing education programs. The Division is committed to excellence in clinical care, education, and research. Clinical activities will include attending on the inpatient and consultation services and working in clinic. It is expected that the applicants will participate in teaching in the setting of clinical teaching units and ambulatory care and be involved in clinical/basic research in areas that complement those of other members of the Division.

In addition to playing an important clinical role in the Department, division members have excellent opportunities for educational and research endeavors with protected time for scholarly activities to ensure rewarding, fulfilling career development.

Academic rank will be dependent upon qualifications & experience. Candidates must have FRCP(C) certification (or equivalent) in Hematology, and be eligible for specialty licensure in Nova Scotia.
