

# Hematologist – locum with a possibility of permanent (Regina)



Saskatchewan's leadership and innovation in healthcare has been evidenced in many ways including through the Provincial Hematology Program. This unique program is led by the Saskatchewan Cancer Agency in partnership with health regions namely the Saskatoon and Regina Qu'Appelle Health Regions. The program focuses on the diagnosis and treatment of patients with both benign and malignant hematological conditions, including full provision of autologous and allogeneic stem cell transplant services.

Depending on their interest and expertise, our physicians practice in various locations including cancer centres in Regina and Saskatoon, hospitals in Regina and Saskatoon and a cadre of office-based environments. Our medical staff is eligible for an academic appointment with the College of Medicine, University of Saskatchewan; and appointment to the medical staff of their respective health region.

The program is seeking a locum hematologist to join the team in Regina to provide primarily general hematology services. Our candidate of choice will be certified in hematology by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (or eligible for certification) or have equivalent education, training and experience. The candidate must be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan as well as a medical staff appointment with the Regina Qu'Appelle Health Region. In accordance with Canadian immigration requirements, preference will be given to Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada.

The Saskatchewan Cancer Agency offers a competitive compensation package. Travel and temporary accommodation may be considered for the locum.
