

The Saskatchewan Cancer Agency operates prevention and early detection programs, conducts innovative research and provides safe, patient and family-centred oncology care at our two comprehensive cancer centres - the Allan Blair Cancer Centre in Regina and the Saskatoon Cancer Centre. We also coordinate the provincial hematology program in partnership with the Saskatoon and Regina Qu'Appelle Health Regions.

We are looking for two hematologists to join our hematology team in Regina. The provincial hematology program focuses on the diagnosis and treatment of patients with both benign and malignant hematological conditions, including full provision of autologous and allogeneic stem cell transplant services. The Regina program is operated in partnership with the Regina Qu'Appelle Health Region.

Preferred candidates will have obtained certification in Hematology with the Royal College of Physicians & Surgeons of Canada or have equivalent education, training and experience. Successful applicants will be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan and must be eligible for membership and privileges with the Regina Qu'Appelle Health Region. In accordance with Canadian immigration requirements, preference will be given to Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada.

The positions will have responsibilities in the care of both benign and malignant patients, the proportion of each to be determined in collaboration with the team, based on the interests of the candidates. Our hematologists are eligible for a clinical appointment in the Division of Oncology, College of Medicine at the University of Saskatchewan. Teaching and research responsibilities are an integral part of program activities. Compensation to be composed of salary, contract and/or fee-for-service, with salary to range between \$327,209 and \$422,266.
