The successful applicant would also provide consultative services for hematologic disorders, actively participate in phase II and III clinical trials, engage in quality improvement initiatives, and work in collaboration with a group of 9 Medical Oncologists/Hematologists. The Osler hematology program includes blood bank, hematopathologists, pharmacists, support staff along with chemotherapy certified nurses, advanced imaging, and hematopathology facilities. We also have a dedicated paediatric/adult hemoglobinopathies program and an adult thrombosis and haemostasis program.

The successful applicant must be able to be licensed to practice in Ontario and hold a fellowship in Internal Medicine from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada with a subspecialty in Hematology (existing or successfully obtained within 1 year of acceptance).
