Hematology Fellowship Opportunities at the Odette Cancer Center (OCC) in Toronto, Canada

The OCC is a tertiary care institution affiliated with the University of Toronto and Sunnybrook Health Sciences Center. The OCC is the second largest comprehensive cancer center in Canada with 10,000 new patients seen annually.

DURATION: 1-2 years

START DATES: January 1 and July 1 of each year but flexible

FUNDING: Available at PGY6 and PGY7 levels. Peer reviewed fellowship funding applications strongly encouraged.

SCOPE:

- Candidates will have the opportunity to refine clinical and research expertise in the management of lymphoid and myeloid malignancies and bone marrow failure syndromes that include AA, PNH, LGL and others. The fellowship can be tailored to the candidate's specific interests.
- Research experience includes clinical trial, translational and/or health service opportunities
- Sunnybrook is an 'MDS Center of Excellence' and an acute leukemia center.
- Candidates will attend 3-4 half day clinics and twice weekly rounds. Remaining time is protected to conduct research projects pertaining to above subspecialties.
- Candidates will function as junior attending on the complex malignant hematology ward for 2 weeks/year and be encouraged to participate in the education of undergraduate and graduate students.
- Fellows are encouraged to pursue post-graduate training in clinical epidemiology, health services research, quality improvement, medical education or basic/translational sciences.
