The Department of Medicine at Sunnybrook Health Sciences Centre is seeking applications for a full-time hematologist to join a group of 3 other physicians who specialize in Thromboembolism. The candidate would have an academic description of Clinician Teacher or Clinician in Quality and Innovation and would have an interest and expertise in Thromboembolism and Benign Hematology. The successful candidate must be eligible for a full-time clinical academic appointment at the rank of Assistant, Associate or Full Professor at the University of Toronto. Effective start time would be January 1, 2022, or possibly earlier with temporary privileges.

The successful candidate must be an MD and have FRCP(C) certification (or equivalencies) in Hematology, and be eligible for specialty licensure in Ontario. Clinical activities will include attending on the inpatient Thromboembolism consultation service and working in outpatient clinics (an interest in Benign Hematology would be an asset). It is expected that the successful applicant will participate in teaching at the undergraduate, postgraduate and continuing education levels and may choose to be involved in clinical research.

Department members have excellent opportunities for education, quality improvement and research endeavors with protected time for scholarly activities to ensure rewarding, fulfilling career development.
